Are you at Risk?

Fire can be devastating and deadly. Follow some of these basic tips to help prevent a possible fire in your home.


- Mount your fire alarm in the centre of the room, hall or stairway, away from doors, windows, air register, fan or vents.
- If your alarm is connected to the wiring system of your house, you should always use a qualified electrician to do the installation and ensure you check the alarm after installation is complete.
- Test your alarm by pressing the test button monthly
- Although battery operated devices warn you when they need to be changed, the batteries should be changed annually.
- Trim candle wicks before lighting, never put them near a draft or vent, and make sure they are on a flat sturdy surface. Keep them out of reach of pets and children.
- Unattended cooking is the number one cause of fires. Keep pot-handles turned in when cooking. Roll up your sleeves while cooking and keep your kitchen free and clean of any greasy mess, including the hood and fan filters.
- Install a carbon monoxide detector it will offer you further protection from lethal emissions.

Wood Stove or Fireplace Check List!

Inspect and clean your chimney.

- The *Technical Standards and Safety Act 2000* requires homeowners to have heating appliances inspected, including chimneys or vents.
- Check stove pipes and connections.
- Check for creosotes.
- Check walls for excessive heat.
- Protect your walls and floor from heat and sparks.
- Install a rain cap.
- Watch for any warning signs.
